

## 2011-12 Upper School Student Supply List

This is a comprehensive list of the materials you will need for all of your classes in the Upper School. You must have these materials with you on the first day of regular classes (Monday, September 6th). Each student MUST have ALL of the following items:

- Five (5) three-ring binders with pockets
  - Spanish – One (1) binder with 5 dividers + 2 pocket folder with holes for binder
  - English – One (1) binder
  - History – One (1) binder
  - Math – One (1) binder, with plastic pocket insert to contain pencils, etc.
  - Science – One (1) binder
  
- One (1) 3-subject notebook for each Science class.
- Index Cards, 3” x 5” pack of 100
- Two (2) single subject spiral notebooks for Math
  
- Loose leaf paper – college-ruled, enough for all binders.
- Graph paper
  
- One (1) packet of colored pencils
- Numerous BLACK ballpoint pens
- Numerous #2 pencils
- Numerous mechanical pencils for Math, erasers
- Large packet (at least 6 colors) of multicolored highlighters for English & Spanish
  
- Ruler, compass, and protractor
  
- One paperback college-level dictionary
- Spanish/English Dictionary
- *501 Spanish Verbs* (Barron’s in paperback) – for advanced & intermediate students only
- Scientific Calculator – Pre-Algebra, Physical Science and Chemistry students
- Graphing Calculator – Algebra I students and above
  
- One box of facial tissues - turned in to your homeroom teacher
  
- Microsoft Word - You will need easy and frequent access to Microsoft Word, or some other application that can read and save files in MS Word format, such as OpenOffice.org. Please be aware that the computers at school are furnished with an older version of word that does not understand the newer “.docx” format and uses the older “.doc” format – plan accordingly. It will be required that many if not all of your papers for you classes will be handed in electronically, as well as on paper.
  
- One USB Memory Stick/Flash Drive – Any type will do. It will be used to transfer papers and ongoing work from home to school. Please make sure it is CLEARLY marked with your name.
