

Camelot Academy 2020-21 Upper School Student Supply List

This is a list of the materials you will need for all of your classes in the Upper School whether Virtual or Hybrid. Each student **MUST** have access to the following items, but may not need them until a later date. Specific courses may request course-specific additional supplies on syllabus. (For example, Physics will need a 10 meter metric measuring tape.)

Beginning August 26th: All students must have access to a laptop or tablet computer for individual use and may be asked to bring that device to school for in-class work if attending on campus. Please also familiarize yourself with the Camelot Academy Technology Agreement. (A copy can be found in the Appendix of the Family Handbook).

- Reliable Internet connection
- Gmail address that clearly identifies user and is school appropriate.
- Word Processing software. You will need easy and frequent access to a word processor. Files must be able to be saved and read in Microsoft Word 2003. If you take Spanish, your word processor should have a Spanish- language spell checker.
- Students must have access to a printer at home.
- If you rely on Google Drive, you must have a way to work offline.
- Student computers should have a working camera and microphone, if at all possible.
- Ability to scan written work via either phone, tablet, printer/scanner.
- Appropriate scanner software
- Headphones or ear plugs for use with computer.

Organization: Students must have a way to organize themselves whether at home or in school. Traditionally, a separate three-ring binder with pockets, dividers and a pencil pouch for each of the following classes you have: Foreign Language, English, History, Science, Social Science, ELL (Given individual organizational needs, some students may choose to have one large binder with multiple sections for various classes.) Stackable trays in student work space/on desk while at home could also be helpful.

- A Quiet /Private space if possible for Virtual classes with room to complete assignments and implement organizational system.
- • Optional Composition Notebooks (1 for each class, English, Fiction Writing, and Latin III)
Work will be accepted typed or written and scanned.
- • Two 3 subject spiral notebooks for Math at all times, (to be replaced as they fill with work).
- • 3-by-5-inch index cards, pack of 100 for Academic Fair
- • Loose leaf, college-ruled paper
- • Colored pencils
- • Numerous black or blue ballpoint pens
- • Numerous regular graphite pencils
- • Selection (at least six colors) of multicolored highlighters for English & Spanish

Math:

- • Ruler, compass, and protractor
- • Calculator
- - Mathematics students in a Discovering series Algebra or Geometry textbook, or in Algebra II or above will require a graphing calculator (e.g., a TI-83).
- Graph Paper
