*You may want to wait to purchase most supplies until students have received their class schedule during Student Orientation, as some supplies are course- or instructor-specific.*

### TECHNOLOGY

- Laptop or tablet computer to bring to school for in-class work
- Charger to use while at school (must bring daily so we encourage having a cord designated for school)
- Headphones or earbuds that connect to the laptop or tablet

On this device, you need:

- Reliable Internet connection at home
- Google Docs
- Gmail address that **clearly** identifies the user and is school-appropriate
- Access to a printer
- Ability to scan written work and submit it via Google Classroom

### ORGANIZATION

- One 1” three-ring binder with 4 dividers for students taking a Spanish course
- Student choice between:
  - An accordion-type folder with pockets for each class
  - **OR** Separate 1” three-ring binders with pockets each class
  - **OR** One large three-ring binder with dividers w/ pockets for each class
  - **OR** sturdy folders for each class

- 36X48 inch Tri-fold board by mid-October for Academic Fair (keep at home)
- Optional - Index cards for Academic Fair and language classes
