At Camelot Academy, we strongly believe that the student must be an active participant in his or her education. A Completed File

Before a decision can be made about accepting a student to Camelot Academy, the school must have a completed file. For international students, a completed file consists of :

- 1. A completed and signed application and \$100 application fee
- 2. A student interview via Skype or WeChat with school officials
- 3. A bank statement showing sufficient funds (\$25,000 or its equivalent) to support student
- 4. An immunization record (in English) showing student has been vaccinated for all the common childhood diseases
- 5. School records going back at least three years showing course work and grades received
- 6. Teacher recommendations from one English teacher and one Math teacher

The Camelot Academy Admissions Process for International Students

The admissions process begins when Camelot Academy receives a completed application and \$100 application fee. A Skype or WeChat appointment is then scheduled and conducted. Camelot Academy will make an admissions decision based on the interview and a completed file. If the student is accepted, enrollment paperwork will be sent both electronically and via a postal service.

When the family returns a signed contract plus all fees and tuition, Camelot Academy issues an I-20 document for the student to obtain an F-1 student visa. If, for any reason, the student is denied a visa, all tuition and fees (except the \$100 application fee) will be refunded to the family per the terms of the contract, as long as a copy of the denial letter is sent to Camelot Academy.
